

Dear TPF Summer Camp Families,

Welcome to TPF Summer Camp! Some of our newer families may have questions and my hope is that this welcome letter will answer most of them for both new and returning families.

So first WELCOME!

Drop off is 7:30 to 9:15 with pick-up anytime before 6pm. The students will have free-time until 9:15am, at which time they will have snack and prepare for their first lesson. At 11:30 we will start clean-up for lunch at 11:45. Your student will need to bring a bag lunch with a drink daily. No microwave items. TPF will provide a morning and afternoon snack.

Students will need to wear tennis shoes for outdoor activities. Uniforms will be worn each afternoon for class at 2:30. Uniforms can be kept at TPF neatly in a drawer. Comfortable and stretchy clothes can be worn with a TPF t-shirt if your student does not have a TPF uniform.

Tuition is due the Friday before the new week or the Monday of the new week. If payments are going to be bi-weekly, please have payment ahead rather than behind.

Electronics may be used during free-time, however, no chargers are to be plugged in at TPF. Electronics should come fully charged. Once they die, bye - bye. With that said - NO VIDEO or PHOTOS are to be taken. Some of our students have strict "NO PHOTO" options in writing that we must adhere to. Further, if any inappropriate content is played all electronics will be banned. This includes inappropriate music and music videos.

Sometimes we all need a rest. Students will be allowed to bring a pillow and blanket with one stuffed animal if they want. Please note, once at TPF these items will stay for the duration of summer camp with the exception of going home for washing. While at TPF these items are to be stored in a garbage bag or backpack.

Toys from home are okay if they can be shared. If a toy is special or fragile and can not be shared, please leave it at home.

Face masks may be worn. If worn incorrectly or if they are left laying around, we may ask that they be put up and away. If your student or family member is at risk and you feel better with your student wearing a mask at all times, please advise our staff.

Our amazing and talented staff members work hard to theme out a safe and fun week for our students. We will do our best to keep you informed of any upcoming field trips. A calendar of events will be available ASAP.
